**DANIEL LEE PICKS UP MAJOR ENDORSEMENTS IN CULVER CITY COUNCIL RACE

CULVER CITY, CA – February 14, 2018 – Daniel Lee’s Culver City Council campaign gained endorsements from leading organizations in recent days, including renowned environmental advocacy group the Sierra Club, as well as garnering the unanimous endorsement of the Los Angeles County Democratic Party, and the Culver City Democratic Club.
